and ideals on one side. On the other side, it will delve into how the very same aesthetic category continues this regime on a pre-predicative level.

Drawing from Martin Seel, Jacques Rancière, and Sianne Ngai, focus of the

analysis will be the globally successful music genre Kawaii Metal and

neighboring phenomena such as Japanese idol music and metal music.
